विषय : शैक्षणिक वर्ष २०१६-१७ मध्ये मा.उच्च न्यायालय, मुंबई यांनी दिलेल्या अंतरिम आदेशांबाबत.

महाराष्ट्र राज्यातील व्यावसायिक अभ्यासक्रमांना प्रवेश घेऊ इच्छिणा-या सर्व विद्यार्थ्यांच्या निदर्शनास आणून देण्यात येते की, शैक्षणिक वर्ष २०१६-१७ मध्ये अखिल भारतीय तंत्रशिक्षण परिषदेने काही संस्थांना अभ्यासक्रम चालविण्यास मुदतवाढ (EOA) दिलेली नाही, तसेच काही संस्थांची प्रवेशक्षमतेत घट करून मुदतवाढ (EOA) दिलेली आहे. तसेच शैक्षणिक वर्ष २०१६-१७ करीता महाराष्ट्र शासनाची मान्यतेच्या अनुषंगाने शासन निर्णय निर्गमित न झाल्यामुळे काही संस्थांनी मा.उच्च न्यायालयात याचिका दाखल केलेल्या होत्या. या रिट याचिकांच्या संदर्भात मा. उच्च न्यायालयाने दिलेल्या अंतरिम आदेशान्वये संबंधित संस्थांचा समावेश केंद्रीभूत प्रवेश प्रक्रियेमध्ये (CAP) करण्यात आलेला आहे तरी, "संबंधित संस्थांमध्ये प्रवेश विद्यार्थ्यांनी आपआपल्या जबाबदारीवर घ्यावेत. विद्यार्थ्यांचे सदर प्रवेश हे मा. उच्च न्यायालयाच्या अंतीम निकालांच्या अधीन असतील" सदर संस्थांचा तपशील खालीलप्रमाणे - :
