The first request for EoI for the selection of industry partner to establish Indian Institute of Information Technology under Public Private Partnership in Maharashtra was floated in June 2011. As selected industries as per the this EoI has expressed unwillingness to work in collaboration and state has decided to explore the possibility of establishing two institutes in the state, one at Pune & other at Nagpur, the fresh EoI for the selection of industry partners is being called as prescribed below –

Ministry of Human Resource Development, Government of India has decided to set up 20 new Indian Institutes of Information Technology on Public Private Partnership (PPP) model in country. As per approved scheme, the Central Government, the State Government and industry will be the stakeholders in the scheme. The details of the scheme are available on www.dte.org.in

Eligibility criteria for applying:

- a) The industry can be both IT as well as non-IT industries. The non-IT industry can be manufacturing companies in which there is a demonstrated use of IT and experience in promoting IT education of repute in the state.
- b) Public sector industries, having large R&D establishment, working in the industry clusters in various states.
- c) The industry partners should be members of Industry Associations such as NASSCOM, FICCI, ASSOCHAM, CII etc.
- d) The industry should normally have been in operation for at least 5 years and should be company of repute with good governance.
- e) The industry should preferably be listed companies with good governance and well regarded in the business community. For those industries, which are not listed, these must have demonstrated track record and good governance.
- f) Minimum of three industry partners must be selected to ensure broad focus in terms of areas of research, necessarily being interdisciplinary is the norm rather than a limited focus within the same subject.

Details to be furnished by the industry partners

- a) Name, address, phone numbers, email-id, website etc. details of the industry with the contact person's details.
- b) Details of IT Projects/assignments in IT education undertaken in the last 5 years.
- c) List of manufacturing facilities, manpower and other relevant details.
- d) Annual audited reports for the last three financial years.
- e) The contribution amount for the establishment IIIT which should be more than Rs. 2 Cores.

The purpose of this EoI is to identify industries willing to work under PPP model with Central and State Governments. Short listed Industries shall be invited for further discussion to enter in to the required Memorandum of Understanding (MoU).
